21 April 1965 – 21 December 2019



The WFOT Executive Management Team and its member organisations were saddened to learn that former Delegate for Argentina, Carolina Alchouron, passed away on 21st December 2019.

Carolina was the Delegate for Argentina commencing in 2012. She received the WFOT Certificate of Service at her final Council Meeting in 2016 in Colombia. During her time on Council, Carolina was involved in WFOT projects, including the review of the membership fee structure. She subsequently served on the WFOT Quality Indicator Framework Working Group from 2016 to 2018.

Carolina was instrumental in ensuring the successful hosting of the WFOT Executive Management Team Meeting in Buenos Aires, Argentina in April 2015. The Executive were privileged to attend a function with the founders of the profession in Argentina and other key people during this visit.

Carolina was a respected clinician and instructor in the use of neurodevelopment treatment with children, in addition to playing an active role with on the board of the Asociacion Argentina de Terapistas Ocupacionales. In 2019, she was recognised with the award of “occupational therapist of the year”.

Every one of us who had the privilege to meet and work with Carolina will remember her warmth, her humour, her intelligence and her significant and passionate commitment to the profession.
